Oxfordshire Sexual Health Service offers support over the phone and at in-person clinics across the county [01865 231231](tel:01865231231) - clinics in Abingdon, Banbury, Bicester, Didcot, Kidlington, Oxford, Wantage, Witney

Those under 16 can book an appointment with Oxford Sexual Health Service or there is a drop in service at the Oxford Clinic (Churchill Hospital) where you can be seen without making an appointment - Mondays 2pm til 6pm (final consultation is 5.30pm).

Other drop-in sessions at the Churchill (drop-in services cannot offer routine HIV care):

Mondays 9 am - 12 pm

Wednesdays 1 pm - 5.30 pm

Fridays 10 am - 4 pm

The Oxfordshire C-Card scheme allows young people aged 13-24 to access free condoms and lube packs - C-Card locations include pharmacies, school health nurses, youth clubs and sexual health and contraceptive clinics. You can also receive them via post.
